What is Project Serve?

Enabling youth to reach beyond themselves effecting positive change in their local community and worldwide, Project Serve is a three-level mission experience training youth in teamwork, commitment and leadership. Participants learn to think about the needs of others and are given the opportunity to serve the homeless and less fortunate in Wetaskiwin, Edmonton and a community in a third world Country. With a focus on God's heart for the poor, teens find joy in seeking the good of others and recognize how God is at work in their lives and in the world.

Who can attend?

Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 who want to make a difference in their world.

Where are we going?

We have no confirmed location at this point in time, but we will likely be headed to The Gambia in West Africa to work with Youth for Christ and help them build a university.

How are we going to do that?

There will be weekly meetings in order to train and grow as a team with a serve trip at the end of each of the first two training levels.
